The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owners' records. If at the end of the 90 day period the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by the American Kennel Club, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC."

### GRAND CHAMPION COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs are entered in this competition:

1. Dogs that are Champions of Record competing in Best of Breed or Best of Variety class.
2. Dogs transferred to Best of Breed/Variety which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed.
3. Champions that win Non-Regular Classes and become eligible for Best of Breed competition. (Altered or spayed CH veteran class winners at independent specialties are eligible.)
4. Winners Dog and Winners Bitch are not eligible for Grand Champion competition.

At the judge's discretion, Grand Championship points may be awarded to:

1. Best of Breed
2. Best of Opposite Sex
3. Select Dog
4. Select Bitch.

Grand Champion competition will not continue beyond Best of Breed competition and in breeds that are divided into varieties, Grand Champion Competition will not continue beyond Best of Variety competition.

**Veterans Exhibition: (7 years old and over)** – Dogs must be AKC registered. Class will follow Veteran's Classes, but dogs entered in this class are **NOT eligible for BOB competition**. Dog may be presented for examination at owner's discretion. **There is NO entry fee for this class. Entry should be accompanied by a 3x5-card description of the dog's lifetime achievements to be read in ring by the steward.**

### **Dual Champion Dog Class**

Any dog that has been awarded the title of Champion of Record may be designated as a "Dual Champion" after it has also been awarded the title of Field Champion. The title of Dual Champion is to recognize those dogs that have shown their superiority in both adhering to the breed standard and their ability to perform the function for which the breed was developed. Classes will be judged after Winners, but before Best of Breed. Entrants may NOT be spayed or neutered. **Dogs & Bitches must be intact, as First Place winner from this class will compete for Best of Breed.**

### **Dual Champion Bitch Class**

## **Non-Regular Classes (Involving Multiple Dog Entries)**

### **Brace Class:**

For two dogs with one common owner. Dogs and Bitches may be entered in the same brace. Dogs comprising a Brace must be named at the time of entry, Specify "Brace Class" on entry form. As the judge's decision in this class will be based on the merits of more than one dog, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

### **Team Class:**

Four dogs with at least one common owner on each dog. Other rules are the same as for Brace Class. Dogs comprising Team must be named at time of entry. If a dog, which is part of a Team, is not entered in another class, it must be marked "For Team Only", fee is \$20.00 for the Unit. If more than one Team is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each Team must be so designated, "Team NO 1", "Team NO 2", etc.

### **Bred-by Exhibitor (BBE) Class Eligibility**

- All dogs entered in the Bred-By Class must be individually registered with AKC.
- The person handling the dog must be a breeder and owner of record on that dog. Family members must be both a breeder and owner of record to exhibit in this class

## **BEST BRED-BY EXHIBITOR COMPETITION**

**RULES:** During the course of regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Bred By Exhibitor from the Bred-By Exhibitor class winners. This will be done after the Best of Breed/Variety Competition unless the Best Bred-By Exhibitor award is automatic. Example: An entry from the Bred-By Exhibitor class is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dogs and bitches undefeated in a Bred-By Exhibitor class are eligible for the Best Bred-By Exhibitor Competition. If the first place winner is not present, the second place winner may not compete.

## AWARD OF MERITS

At the conclusion of the regular Best of Breed judging, the judge may at his/her discretion award up to a maximum of six (6) Awards of Merit, to any competitor for Best of Breed **other than the final Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, and Winners Dog and Winners Bitch**. The judge is not obligated to award any Awards of Merit, if he/she feels there are not any dogs or bitches in competition worthy of this award. The total number of Awards of Merit the judge is allowed to award is dictated by the total number of Dogs and Bitches, the COUNT to include the WD and the WB, competing in the Best of Breed Competition as follows:

# AKC Code of Sportsmanship

*PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.*

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
